Class of 2023 Graduation Requirements

- Earn a 2.6 or higher in all courses assigned for the 2022 - 2023 school year.
- Earn a score of 240 or higher - MCAS English Language Arts, Mathematics and Biology.
- Missed no more than 12 days of school.
- Completed all courses with a 2.6 or higher in grades 9th – 11th. This includes all credit recovery courses.
